


Anti-stress Coloring Book

For this project I created a series of 19 doodles using ink directly on paper. The ideas for each page are very different as I was aiming to achieve a dynamic book with different moods. After each page was ready they were scanned and vectored traced to be able to adjust scale and line thickness. When ready, I printed more than 200 copies and I was invited to sell them in a famous book-store from Belo Horizonte called Leitura. After it sold out I released the 19 pages on facebook coloring fan-pages, so the members could download for free and share. The idea behind the book is to entertain the colorist by hiding objects or just by providing the opportunity to combine figures and create new ones.

The objects created for Los Dois are very different, they go from chairs, stools, ceramic, cardboard boxes, wooden chests and canvas with different sizes and shapes. Using doodling as a tool, I created textures or figures to cover each piece, each one has various elements and hidden objects, they provide an eye-catching experience for the observer, also by changing the position of the object you can find different shape combinations or figures that resemble something in your own mind. I lost count of the number of items that were created, some of them I don't know where they currently are, others I do and some times I miss to have around.

The coloring process has a rule that makes coloring a bit fun and at the same time challenging, the rule is simple, there can't be two parts using the same color touching each-other.


